When Charles Henry Black was born on 27 February 1871, in Kanosh, Millard, Utah, United States, his father, Joseph Smith Black, was 34 and his mother, Sarah Jane Barney, was 25 (Center of Photo. To her right: Clarinda Louisa-Sister. To her left: Henry. To her lower right: Ada Rebeca-Sister. To her lower left: Parley Pratt-brother).

He married Mabel Annette Warner on 1 December 1892, in Deseret, Millard, Utah, United States. They were the parents of at least 5 sons and 11 daughters. He lived in United States in 1949 and Ogden, Weber, Utah, United States in 1950. He died on 27 November 1951, in Provo, Utah, Utah, United States, at the age of 80, and was buried in Ogden City Cemetery, Ogden, Weber, Utah, United States.

Brief Life History of Mabel Annette Warner Black

When Mabel Annette Warner was born on 14 February 1876, in Fillmore, Millard, Utah, United States, her father, Byron Warner, was 43 and her mother, Ann Sophia Tyler, was 41. She married Charles Henry Black on 1 December 1892, in Deseret, Millard, Utah, United States. They were the parents of at least 5 sons and 11 daughters. She lived in Ogden City Election Precinct, Weber, Utah, United States in 1940 and United States in 1949. She died on 21 May 1960, in Ogden, Weber, Utah, United States, at the age of 84, and was buried in Ogden City Cemetery, Ogden, Weber, Utah, United States.

News Clips-Anniversary Article – 1942 - “Charles Black and His Wife Are Felicitated”

OGDEN, Dec. 5 — Mr. and Mrs. Charles Henry Black held open house for friends and relatives last Wednesday on their golden wedding anniversary.

They entertained at dinner Nov. 29, at their home, 586 First Street, for children and grandchildren. Thirty-eight persons were seated at a U-shaped table decorated with crystal candelabra, blue candles, gold-colored chrysanthemums and streamers of gold-colored ribbon leading to place cards and flowers. Nine of their living children were present.

Charles Henry Black, oldest son of Joseph S. and Sarah Jane Barbey Black of Deseret, Millard County, and Mabel A. Warner, only daughter of Byron and Ann Sophia Tyler Warner of Fillmore, were married Dec. 1, 1892, by the groom's father, Bishop Joseph S. Black. On March 15 of the same year, the couple traveled with others by team and covered buggy to Manti, where a marriage was performed in the Manti Temple.

Most of their married life has been spent in Idaho, where Mr. Black was a dairy farmer. He is now employed at the Quartermaster Depot at Second Street. The couple has lived in Ogden and vicinity for the past eleven years.





Charles Henry Black was born on February 27, 1871, in Kanosh, Millard County, Utah, the son of Joseph Smith Black and Sarah Jane Black. In the spring of 1875, he came as a young child with his parents to Deseret, where his father served as the community's first bishop. The Black family were among the very first settlers, and Charles was one of the earliest children raised in the settlement.

From an early age, he shared in the labor that shaped the region, working alongside his father on canals and dams, including the Abraham Canal, and later planting the first grain in the Abraham district with his brother, Peter T. Black. His youth combined schooling in Deseret with studies at the Millard Stake Academy in Fillmore.

On December 1, 1892, Charles Henry Black married Mabel Annette Warner. Their marriage was solemnized in the Manti Temple on March 15, 1893. The couple began their married life in Deseret, later moving to Riverton, where Mr. Black operated his own mercantile business. In 1902, they relocated to Idaho, where Mr. Black engaged in farming and stock raising and became a pioneer in the Snake River, Lost River, and Twin Falls valleys. His work there reflected both enterprise and endurance, qualities that marked his entire life.

Throughout his years, Mr. Black remained deeply committed to The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. He served as superintendent of Sunday Schools in multiple Idaho wards, sat on a stake Sunday School board, and at the time of his death was a member of the high priests quorum of the Ogden Twenty-ninth Ward. In 1929, the Blacks moved to Ogden, which remained their home for the rest of his life. Charles Henry Black passed away at the age of eighty following a short illness, on November 21, 1951. He was survived by his wife, ten children, thirty-four grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, and numerous brothers and sisters, leaving behind a legacy rooted in faith, pioneering labor, and family devotion. Funeral services were held in the Ogden Twenty-ninth Ward, with burial in the Ogden City Cemetery.

Millard County right in the middle of the modern state Utah, where today Interstate-15 runs through it. Charles Henry (CH) the son of avid LDS man, Joseph S. Black, his mother, Sarah, the 2nd of four wives have life about settling the region.

Mabel Warner's family came from NY. Her father, Byron, the only son of Pioneer, Orange Warner & Delilah. Orange joined the Church in 1951 and ultimately trekked to Millard County. [Orange Warner - Family Search](#)
 My Great Grandmother Mabel, died in 1960 at age 84 in Ogden. She had 16 babies! Thus, they would be "Black Cousins" that held reunions through life.

I knew of this man as Uncle Jay, my Grandfather, Bry's, hunting and fishing buddy. Married Elizabeth Webb, they had 7 children-1 boy, 6 girls -all married.

I do not recall Alberta. She served a mission in Sudan at age 22, 1918, married George Simmons, 1924. They lost 3 children at/near birth. I knew of 4th-Bob Simmins(1936-2012).

I heard name, Aunt Lavern. She married Willard Lamborn. Of their 4 daughters, Carol Jean, and Marilyn had some time in plural marriages – La Colina Lebaron, Mexico.

The family moves to Salt Lake County. Bry is 4th. Marries Melba Douglass. They have 3 daughters, my Mom Barbara, and my two Aunts, Annette and Marcia.

Cousin Count so far: 7+4+4+3 = 18 so far. The cousins held reunions, sure they thought of those lost early.

I heard the name Uarda. She married Roy King Sr. Their life in So. Idaho brought 5 children. Roy King Jr. is a cousin I met. Widowed in 1969, Uarda, age 71, married Henry Terry, then passed in 1977, age 76.

No recall Nora. She married La Vaughn Lamoreaux. They had 2 daughters living in North Ogden, Twin Falls, and Oakland. I think my family visited Lamoreaux's on a trip to San Francisco, maybe a daughter's (cousin) family.

Aunt Thelma is a familiar name. She married Cyril Kirtley. They lived So. Idaho, their 1 daughter then born in Seattle. Moved to Carmichael, CA at some point, Cyril died in 1978, and Thelma died 20 years later, 1998 also there.

Iris is a name heard. She Married Don Riggs (1928 div?) and lived in So. Idaho. Married Byron Humphries (1930 div). Married Howard Portor (1934) and lived in Los Angeles. Some point moved to Boise/as Howard died there 1973 and she did too 20 years later 1993. They had 1 daughter, Donna Porter.

No sense of Karl. He married Raida Arlene Clark. Lived in So. Idaho - No children.

Cousin Count so far: 7+4+4+3+5+2+1+1 = 27 so far.

Know this name, Aunt Rhoda. Married George Erickson (1929). They lived So. Idaho. There are 2 children, Donis Erickson (1935-2025) and Gaylord Erickson (1935-Deceased). I have met Don Erickson.


A Pioneer legacy. Classic study of Mormon Settlement of Utah. He was my grandfather's grandfather.

Afton. Curious little on Family Search. One photo. She had short 3 year marriage to Francis V. Brown (m.1935), divorced-no offspring. Had nervous disorders and was treated at Utah State Hospital from 1938 until 1968, thereafter lived out life in nursing home, passed in 1984.

Zelene. Also very little. No marriage or offspring. She also had nervous disorders and was treated at Utah State Hospital from 1935 to 1963, thereafter likely in nursing homes until in Heber City when passed in 2000.

Inez. This name heard. She is 2nd wife to Clyde Rackham(1936). So. Idaho, Ogden, Los Angeles, Sacramento. Have 3 children. Buried together in Ogden.

Ganes. A name heard. Married Agnes Delahunty (1943) in Los Angeles. Lived Sacramento. Spent time in Taiwan, as child, Gregory Black was born there.

Rose Lived in So. Idaho, and then Ogden. She died at age 14 (1935). Buried Ogden City Cemetery.

Charles Ray - a name I heard often. He was born Twin Falls, grew up in Ogden. Military drafted 30 June 1942. Sergeant in US Army from 1 Jan 1943 to 13 June 1945. Clark Air base, Philippines. Radio operator on B-25, listed missing over Formosa on a mission.

Of 16 children, a few died young, a few died in their age range of 60, many lived past 80.
